2. Type and purpose of the data

For the purpose of selecting candidates, we only collect the data that applicants provide us with in writing or electronically. These are your contact details (full name, address, e-mail address, telephone number) as well as the information provided in your application (e.g.: CV, qualification, previous experience, previous work assignments, marital status, hobbies, etc.).

3. Disclosure of data to third parties

There is no transfer of your personal data to third parties.

4. Your rights

You have the right to:

- Pursuant to Art. 7 sec. 3 GDPR, revoke your once-granted consent at any time against us. As a result, we will no longer be able to continue the processing of data based on this consent and delete it for the future.
- Pursuant to Article 15 GDPR, to request information about your personal data processed by us. In particular, you can provide information on the processing purposes, the category of personal data, the categories of agents against which your data have been or will be disclosed, the planned retention period, the existence of a right of rectification, disclosure, restriction of processing or opposition, the existence of a right of appeal, the origin of their data, if they have not been collected from us, and the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, where applicable, information.
- Pursuant to Article 16 GDPR, it is possible to request the correction of inaccurate or complete ingestion of your personal data stored by us.
- Pursuant to Article 17 GDPR, to require the disclosure of your personal data stored by us, unless processing is necessary for the exercise of the right to free expression and information, for the exercise of a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or for the assertion, practice or defense of legal proceedings.
- Pursuant to Article 18 GDPR, to require the restriction of the processing of your personal data in so far as the accuracy of the data is disputed by you, the processing is unlawful, but you refuse its use and we no longer require the data, but you have objected to it for the purposes of asserting, practicing or defending legal claims or you have objected to the processing in accordance with Article 21 of the GDPR.
- Pursuant to Article 20 GDPR, to obtain your personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, relevant and machine-readable format or to request the transfer to another controller.
- Article 77 GDPR to complain to a supervisory authority. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority of your local place of residence or workplace or our registered office.

5. Routine processing and blocking of personal data

We process and store your personal data only for the period necessary to achieve the purpose of storage or if this has been provided for by the European legislator or another legislator in laws or regulations to which the controller is subject.

If the purpose of storage is taken up or if a storage period prescribed by the European legislator or another relevant legislator is required, the personal data shall be routinely blocked or approved in accordance with the statutory provisions.

6. Right of objection and withdrawal, requests for cancellation and correction

You have the opportunity at any time to revoke your consent to the processing of personal data with effect from the future and to have your personal data available or from the end of the year. If the data are required for the performance of the contract or for the performance of pre-contractual measures, an early processing of the data is only possible unless contractual or legal obligations preclude a regulation.
